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# School Community Feedback Survey Report 

## Introduction

The School Community Feedback Survey has been structured to establish whether a school meets expectations using single inventories. Surveys are specific to each stakeholder group, parent, student, and faculty/staff to allow for clarity - both in framing questions for the respondent and in disaggregating data for school use.

The surveys include items in the following categories: mission and engagement, curriculum and program, classroom experience, administration, athletics, fine arts, clubs and co-curriculars, campus safety and security, life and learning skills, student support, and welcoming and inclusive. Supplemental and optional categories include faith-based program, dining services, and uniform dress code.

Additionally, stakeholders are asked to give the school a Net Promoter Score® rating of 1-10 with the opportunity to include a narrative comment.

## Methodology

All responses are confidential. After basic demographic information, respondents are asked to rate their performance expectations for the areas in the categories listed above. Generally, response options are more than expected, as expected, less than expected with a corresponding numerical value of 5,3 , and 1 . When appropriate an option of not applicable is available. Individual responses are converted to numerical values, and means are calculated to allow comparison between groups. While not a direct comparison, these means offer schools an opportunity to identify similarities and differences with previous versions of this survey.

## Reading Your Report

Each stakeholder report begins with group demographics. Following this section, you will find individual item charts and comparisons of divisions (grade levels for students) and length of time with the school. Net promoter analysis and narrative commentary organized by net promoter score follows. These comments were solicited at the end of the survey in response to the question - why did you give the school the rank you did (relative to the previous question, "How likely are you to recommend the school to colleagues or friends?"). Stakeholders are then given the opportunity to leave final remarks, positive or negative, for the school. Schools that choose to include optional sections on dining, uniforms, and/or faith-based program will find analysis and narrative comments on those sections at the end of this report.

## Next Steps

As appropriate, these results can be shared with administrative teams, boards, and other stakeholder groups. Use the results to celebrate areas of success and to think strategically about the future. Many schools use this feedback to inform accreditation goals.

## When to Give the Survey Again

The purpose of the survey is to reliably determine expectations and satisfaction of stakeholders and to recognize areas in which the school can improve performance and/or communications. SAIS recommends administering the survey at least every five years, as the school begins its accreditation cycle. Many schools choose to survey more often, typically every three years.
